Series: Prepare the House

Message Title: Make Room

Isaiah 54:2-3a NIV

“Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. For you will spread out to the right and to the left;”

Point 1: Make Room in Your Heart

- Before God stretches the house, He stretches our hearts.
- Growth means welcoming people who may not think, act, or look like us.
- Ask God: “Where does my heart need to stretch to make room for what You want to do?”

Matthew 9:17 NLT

“No one pours new wine into old wineskins.”

- New wine needs new wineskins — to receive new people, God has to stretch our hearts.

1 Peter 4:10 NIV

“Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”

Point 2: Make Room in Your Hands

- Serving prepares the house for the harvest.
- Every gift matters — we all have a part to play.
- Ask God: “Where do You want my hands in this next season?”

Ephesians 3:20 NIV

“Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.”

Point 3: Make Room in Your Faith

- Expectation sets the atmosphere for God to move.
- God can do immeasurably more than we ask or imagine — but we need to prepare for what we're praying for.
- Ask God: "How are You stretching my faith right now?"
